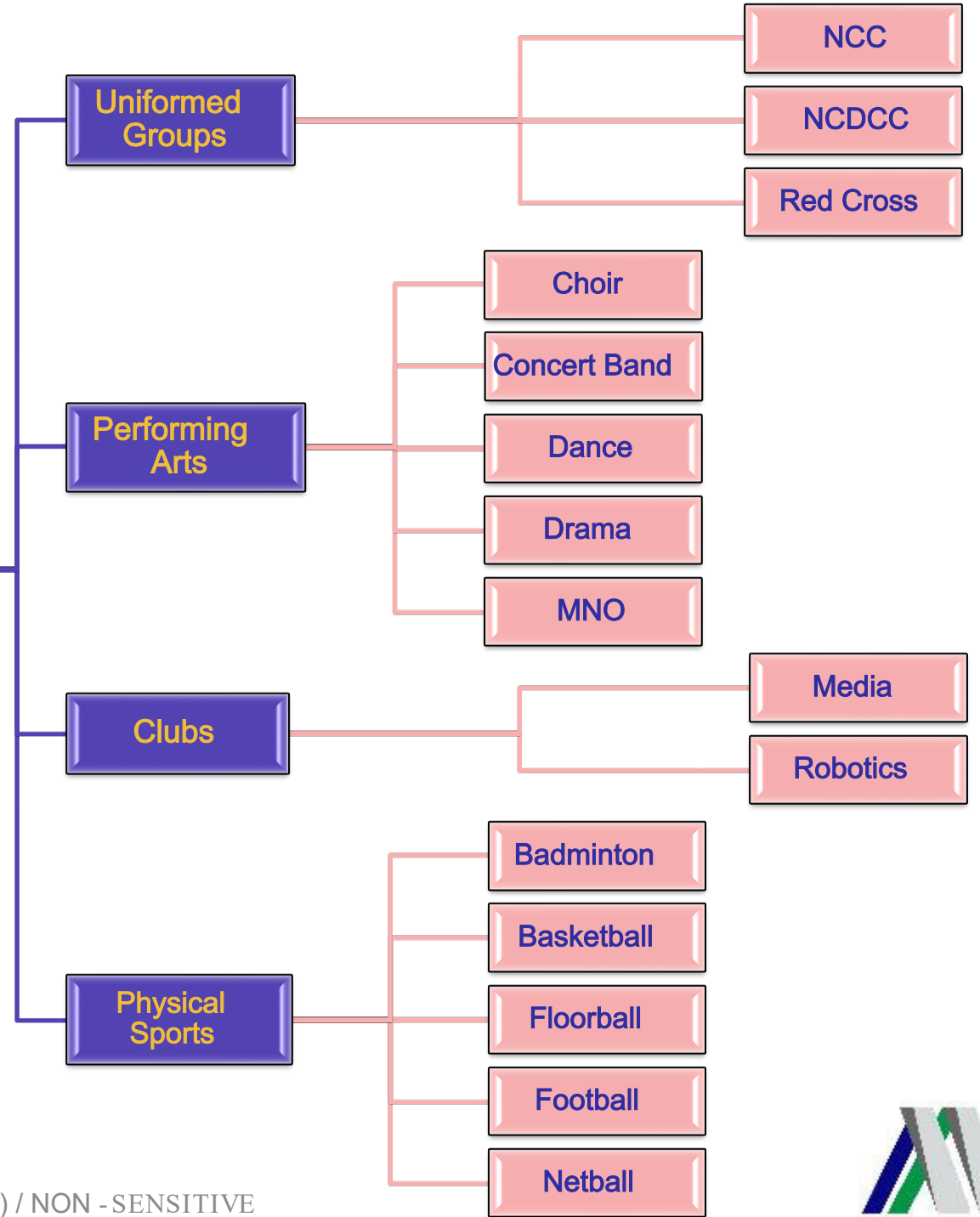
Objectives for Co-Curricular Activities (CCAs)

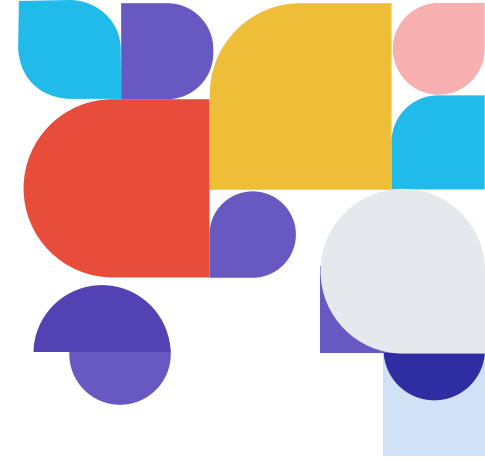

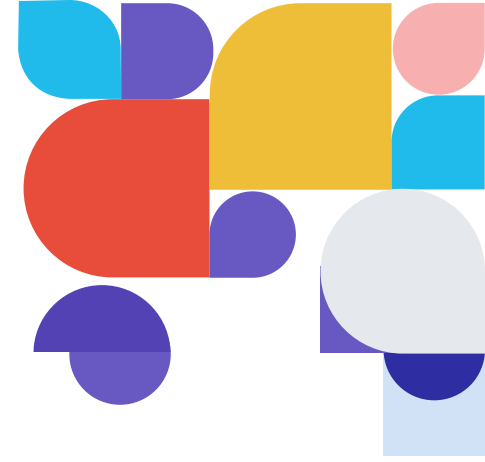

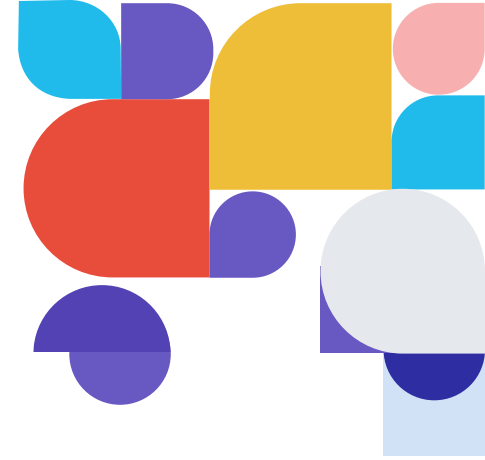


Robotics Club

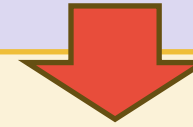
Meridian CCA Operations

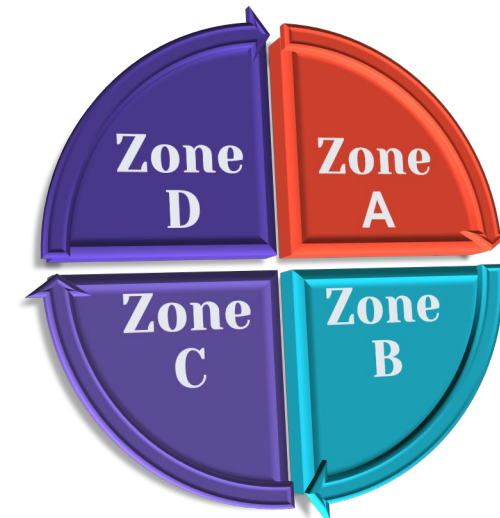

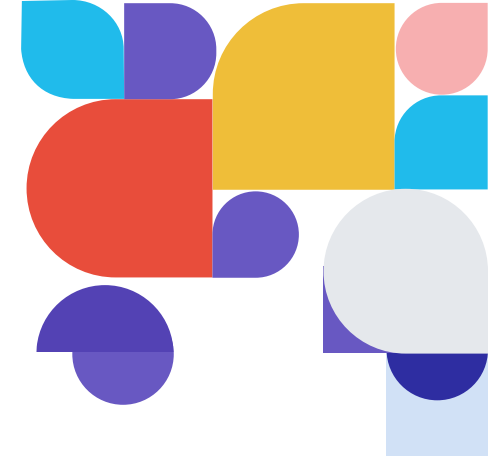

LEVELS OF ATTAINMENT – ‘EXCELLENT’ – 2 BONUS



Example A :

Student has attained a minimum Level 3 in all four domains and at least Level 4 in one domain (Participation). Hence, the student’s co-curricular attainment is recognised as Excellent.

Domain	Description of Attainment	Level
Participation	Participated in the <u>same</u> CCA for 4 years with at least 75% attendance for each year	4
Achievement	Represented school at local competition / conference / festival / exhibition for 2 years	3
Leadership	Committee for school-wide events	3
Service	Completed at least 24 hours of service <u>and</u> at least one VIA project that impacts the school or community	3



LEVELS OF ATTAINMENT – ‘GOOD’ – 1 BONUS



Example B :

The student has attained a minimum of Level 1 in all domains with at least Level 2 in three domains. Hence, the student’s co-curricular attainment is recognised as Good.

Domain	Description of Attainment	Level
Participation	Participated in any CCA for 3 years with at least 75% attendance for each year	2
Achievement	Represented class / house / CCA at intra-school event	1
Leadership	Class Committee	2
Service	Completed at least one VIA project that impacts the school or community	2
